

2025 Fellowship Greenville Father / Son Campout - FAQs

How much will this cost?	<p>The cost is \$75 per family (includes father and all sons).</p> <p>Additional adults, like grandfathers, are welcome to attend for an additional \$25 as well.</p>
Who should come?	<p>Grandfathers/Fathers with sons six years old through 18.</p> <p>(For families without a father present, a grandfather can bring his grandsons for the \$75 cost. For families that will be bringing father and son(s), their grandfather can come and participate as “additional adult” mentioned above.)</p>
What are we doing?	<p>This year’s campout will be on lake hartwell. We will be several activities in and around the water. We will be competing as multiple teams.</p> <p>Tentative Itinerary:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Friday night: Orientation, Dinner, Large Group Campfire, and 1st Nighttime Team Challenge • Saturday Morning: Father/Son Devotional, Morning Team Challenge, Lunch, Free Time, Afternoon Team Challenge, Dinner & S’mores Bar, Father/Son Blessing Ceremony • Sunday: Father/Son Devotional, Breakfast, Competition Awards, Free Time and Tear Down.
What food is covered?	<p>The cost of the trip will cover all three meals on Saturday and Breakfast on Sunday.</p> <p>Friday dinner is not provided. Consider taking your son out for dinner on the way in or bringing your own food for Friday night.</p>
What clothes should I bring?	<p>Look at the local Anderson, SC forecast to determine the thickness of clothes that you and your son will need. It is suggested that you bring an extra layer/jacket to wear after sunset. Additionally, bring a couple of extra changes of clothes since there will be multiple water activities. Wet clothes outside also get dirty and muddy.</p>
What camping gear should we bring?	<p>This is a primitive camp set up with limited water and restrooms available. There is a central water faucet and restroom. You will need to bring at minimum:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tent • Sleeping Mat & Bag & Pillow • Clothes • Bathing Suit(s) • Towel(s) • Life Preservers (if needed) • Toiletries & Medications • Flashlights (w/ extra batteries)

	<p>Additional items could include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tarp & Ropes • Pocketknife • Fire Starters • Personal Snacks • Fishing Gear (Don't forget to purchase a license.) • Water Bottle • Kayak, Paddleboards, Canoes (required to have life preservers.)
When	<p>October 3-5</p> <p>Plan to arrive between 3:00 and 7:00 pm on Friday, Oct. 3.</p> <p>Checkout is at 12:00 noon on Sunday, Oct. 5th.</p>
Where	<p>Sadlers Creek State Park - 940 Sadlers Creek Rd, Anderson, SC 29626</p> <p>From Greenville, take I-85 South. Take Exit 14 and turn left onto SC 187. Follow SC 187 for approx. 13 miles. Turn left onto State Road S-4-741 (Sadlers Creek Rd.). Stay straight until the end of the road. We will be camping on the right side at the end of the road.</p>
Other Details	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Safety Rules are as follows: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ No one-on-one (Adult and youth) that isn't father/son or grandfather/grandson ○ Two-deep adult leadership. Outside of father and son, there should always be at least two adults present around youth. ○ Youth need to stay in buddy groups of at least three people when going out alone. ○ Fathers and Grandfathers are responsible for the safety of their children especially around the water. ○ Life preservers should be worn in deep water. (water over your head) • No BB guns should be brought in this year since we are in a public State Park. • All camping areas are primitive, tent-only camping areas. There are NO sites that have electricity or water hookups. • The Saturday evening blessing ceremony is a time where Fathers publicly bless their son(s) in front of the large fellowship of men. In the past some Fathers have used this time to give a special gift to their sons. A gift is not required, but could be a memorable keepsake for your son(s). <p>The church website link will have more information as it becomes available.
